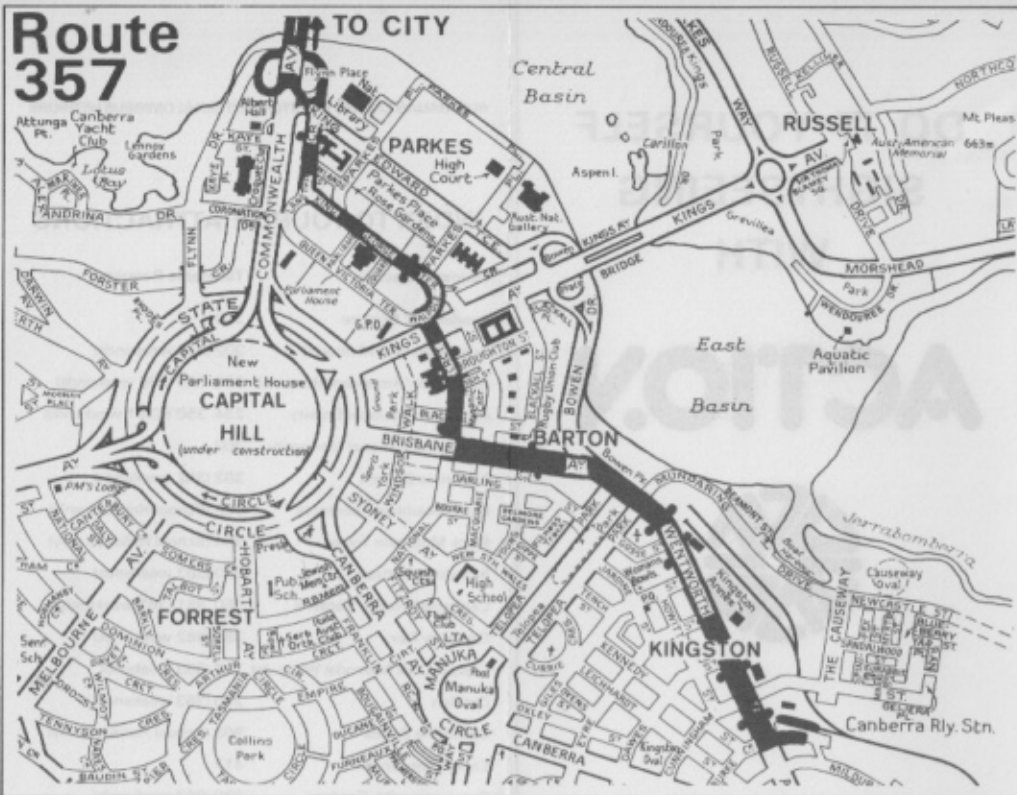
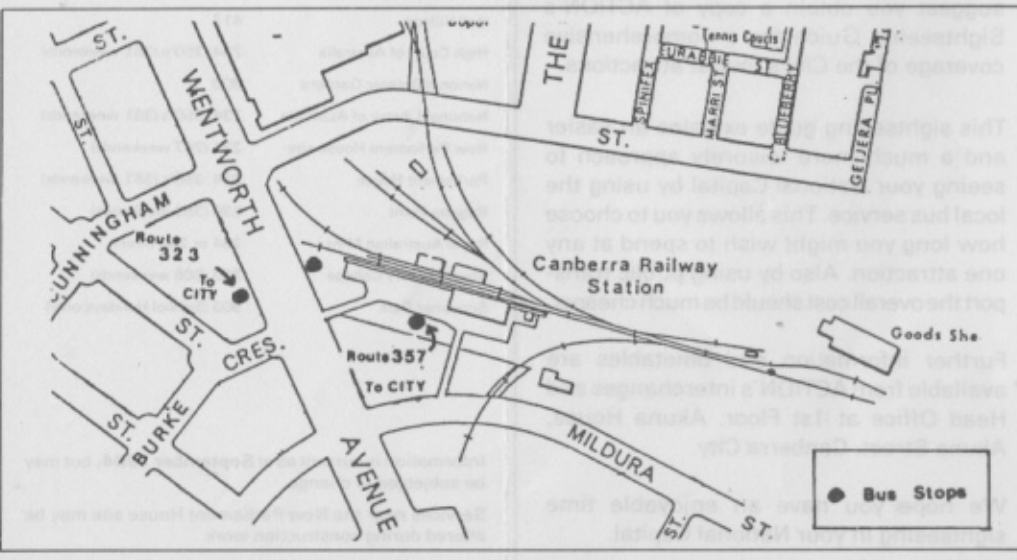

Route 357 operates direct from City Interchange to and from the Railway Station to connect with specific trains. All Route 357 services connect in the City with the Express Route 333 to Belconnen and Woden.

Buses on Route 323 operate past the Railway Station in Wentworth Avenue every 30 minutes between 6.33 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. (Monday to Friday) and 7.03 a.m. and 11.33 a.m. (Saturday). For timetable information please telephone 47 6185 or collect a timetable from the ticket office at the station.

There are **NO** bus connections for train departures on Saturday and Sunday at 7.13 a.m. and the train arrival on Sunday at 10.41 p.m.
