All times referred to in this planner are times the bus will leave and arrive back at the Jolimont (Tourist Bureau) Terminal. Details of arrival and departure times at points of interest included on ACTION Sightseeing Specials are shown inside each timetable.

### Example:

Catch the 10.12 am trip to Red Hill (Route 905) returning at 11.40 am; then get the 12 noon The Tower (Route 904) which returns at 1.13 pm. Have a quick snack at Jolimont before going on The Cotter at 1.35 pm. This bus arrives back at Jolimont at 4.53 pm.

#### Route 904

1. Australian National Botanic Gardens

The Gardens occupy about 40 hectares of land on the lower slopes of Black Mountain and are devoted almost exclusively to Australian native flora. Features include a marked nature trail, aboriginal trail, rainforest gully, display room, horticulture centre and bookshop.


Open daily: 9 am-5 pm

You may alight here or continue on to the Telecom Tower.

### 2. Telecom Tower

The Tower has three public viewing galleries, snackbar, a revolving restaurant, exhibition room and theatrette. The view from the Tower affords a 360° panorama of Canberra, its satellite towns and the surrounding countryside. The bus waits 35 minutes allowing sufficient time to take the 66 metre elevator ride (admission not included in bus fare) to the viewing platforms of the Tower.
