All times referred to in this planner are times the bus will leave and arrive back at the Jolimont (Tourist Bureau) Terminal. Details of arrival and departure times at points of interest included on ACTION Sightseeing Specials are shown inside each timetable.

### Example:

Catch the 10.12 am trip to **Red Hill** (Route 905) returning at 11.40 am; then get the 12 noon **The Tower** (Route 904) which returns at 1.13 pm. Have a quick snack at Jolimont before going on **The Cotter** at 1.35 pm. This bus arrives back at Jolimont at 4.53 pm.

### Day Tripper Tickets

A 'Day Tripper' ticket entitles you to unlimited travel on any regular ACTION bus, for the day marked on the ticket. You can buy a ticket on the day (except Sunday) or in advance from any of the interchanges.

There is also a 'Mini Day Tripper' for children, school students and pensioners.

# The What, Where and When of ACTION Sightseeing

## What you see

### Route 906

#### 1. Belconnen Interchange

The ACTION Suburban bus service reflects Canberra's land use distribution and road system. Canberra consists of four towns, each with a town centre and bus interchange (or one planned). ACTION's feeder bus routes run into the interchanges and the inter-town express route 333 links the town centre interchanges.

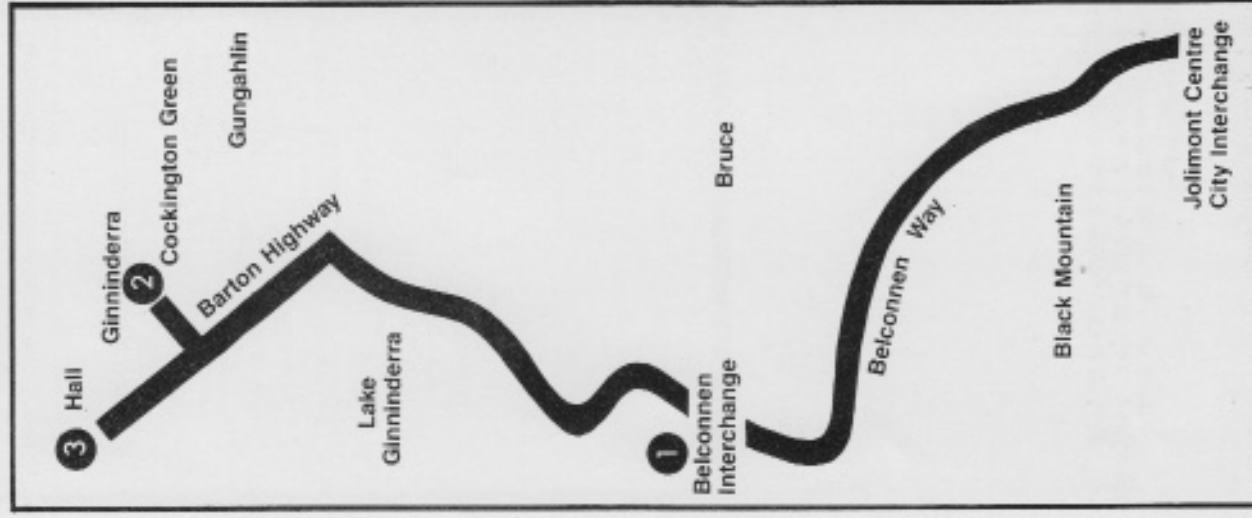
Belconnen's award winning interchange is connected to all shops and offices in the town centre by a network of walkways; pedestrians do not have to cross any roadway at ground level.

If, on your return from Ginninderra and Hall you wish to visit Belconnen Mall, one of the largest fully enclosed shopping centres in Australia, just get off 'Two Villages' bus at Belconnen and, later on in the day, catch any 333 intertown bus from platform 13, back to the City. Intertown buses leave Belconnen for City every 15 minutes throughout the day.

2. Ginninderra and Hall, both situated on the old Queanbeyan to Yass Road, pre-date 3. Canberra. Ginninderra's first settlers arrived in the 1820s and the village developed to be one of the main settlements on the Yass Road, eventually comprising a post office (opened 1859), a general store, blacksmith, church, school and cricket ground. The school opened in 1884 and closed in 1911 when the new school in Hall was built. By this time Hall had surpassed Ginninderra in importance.

Today the Ginninderra School House and Church have both become part of the new 'Village' combining Australian and English historical interests. The original colonial buildings, which are now part of an arts and crafts centre, have been joined by 'Cockington Green', a superb miniature village based on buildings in Great Britain, set in a garden landscape. Included within Cockington Green is The Parsons Nose Licensed Restaurant and a Steam Train ride around the property. Nearby is the George Harcourt Inn, a new 'Tudor Style' English pub.

### Departure points:

All buses depart from Bay 8, Jolimont Coach Terminal at the rear of the Canberra Tourist Bureau in Northbourne Avenue and then two minutes later from Bay 2, City Interchange, East Row outside Youngs Store.

\* There are no services on Christmas Day, New Year's Day or Good Friday.

- City to Ginninderra/Hall is a two section trip.
- Belconnen to Ginninderra/Hall is a one section trip.
