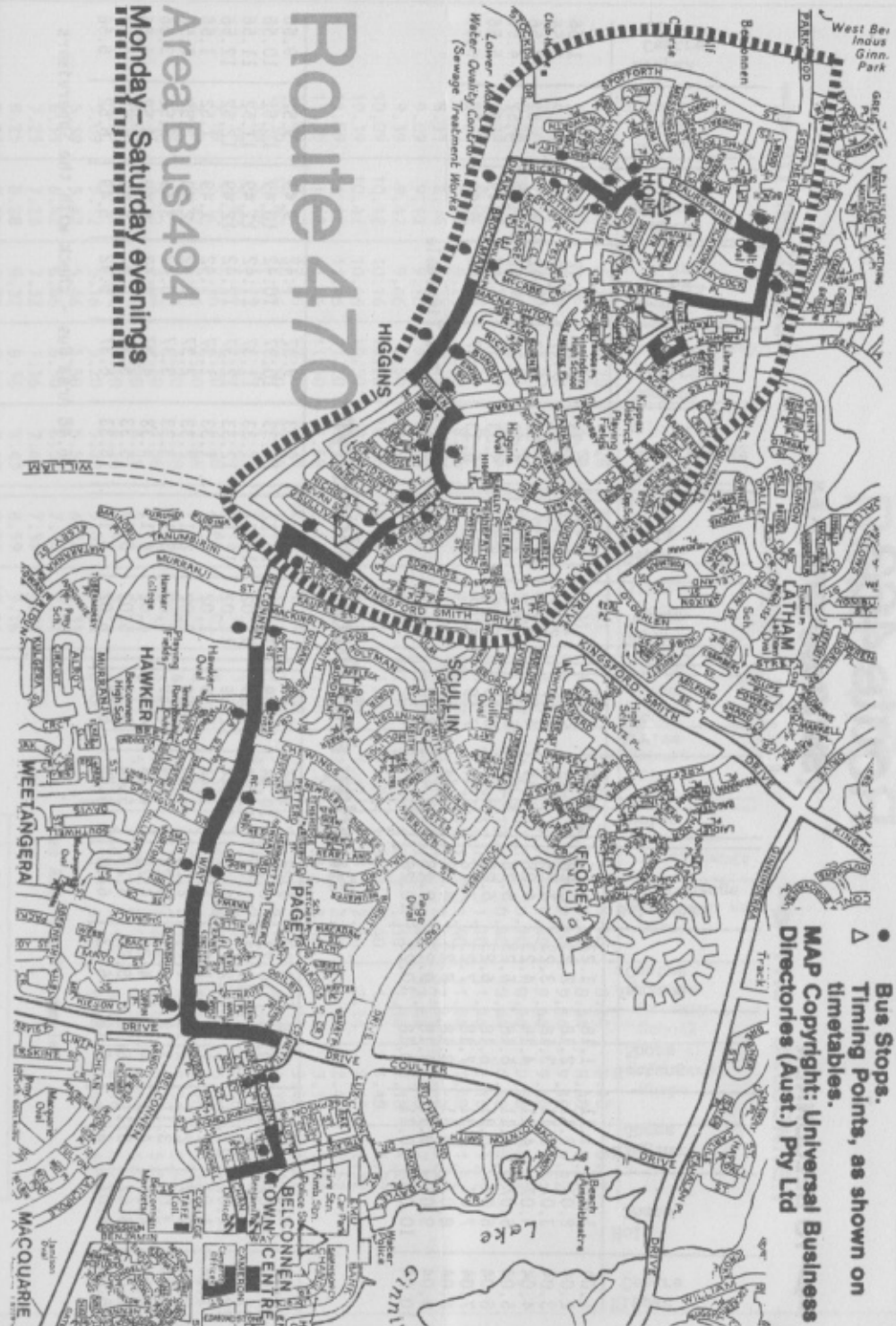

Monday to Saturday Evenings

Area Buses operate outbound from the interchange to any stop within the area marked by dotted lines on the weekday route map.

**Check the map carefully and use the Area Bus that is most suitable for you.

To use an Area Bus:

1. From the Interchange -

board the bus and advise the driver of your destination ie your bus stop. The driver will plan the best route for all passengers and will stop at your stop.

2. Within the area but travelling further out within the area -

ring the duty supervisor on 520239 or 520246 and advise him of your location and destination, he will provide details of the next area bus past your stop.

3. Towards the Interchange -

use the inbound services as detailed on this pamphlet.

PRE-PURCHASED TICKETS

We have a variety of pre-purchased tickets to suit your travel needs.

1. **Monthly Bus Card** — providing unlimited travel for a calendar month
2. **Weekly Bus Card** — providing unlimited travel for 7 days (Monday to Sunday)
3. **Quarterly Bus Card (*Concessions only)**
Q1 JAN, FEB, MARCH
Q2 APRIL, MAY, JUNE
Q3 JULY, AUG, SEPT
Q4 OCT, NOV, DEC
4. **Day Tripper Tickets** — providing unlimited travel for one day
5. **Fare Go Tickets** — single ride tickets in books of 10 (not valid on Route 333 or express services)

*Concession travel is available to children up to 15 years, High School students, College students and Tertiary students with **ACTION** Authority Cards and any other persons with an **ACTION** Authority card or Transport Concession Card.
